19. Improvements in library services:

The College received a sum of Rs. 13,05,000.00 as assistance from the University Grants Commission. An amount of Rs. 4,50,000.00 towards purchase of books and periodicals for the Library, Rs. 8,55,000.00 for the purchase of equipments.

At present the College Library has a total collection of 22522 books including General Allotment/ UGC/ Self-financed and Donated Books.

Our College library has got a new international model look by providing the glass fabrication and false ceiling with centralized lighting and creation of Librarian Chamber, reading hall.

A new section has been created in the central library starting a UGC Network Resource Centre with 10 computers with a printer to access the E-Resource by the student and staffs. Our college library has become an institutional member of INFLIBNET's NLIST consortia.

20. New books /Journals subscribed and their cost:

The College Library subscribes to 98 national and international periodicals, journals and dailies worth Rs.37,000.00 in all subjects. Annual allotment of Rs. 12,000.00 under general plan and Rs. 25,000.00 under the UGC XI Plan were allotted this year.

Students' assessment by teachers is being done to all courses through tests and assignments. IQAC collects the feedbacks every year. The outcome of the evaluation and its analysis are intimated through the principal to the HODs for improvement and remedial measures.

23. Computerization of administration:

Our office has been fully computerized for all the administrative work related to the office and the office staffs are now provided a comfortable working environment. Each dept has been supplied with a PC and internet facility.

24. Increase in infra structural facilities

- ❖ The existing library and exam section were renovated with false ceilings and UGC Network Resource Center was added.
- ❖ EPBX Box was installed for better communication purpose.
- ❖ To handle power cut problem, inverters have been installed connecting the college office, principal's room and the Committee room.
- ❖ A new generator was also purchased to cope with emergency power problems.

- ❖ Refurbishing work was done in the existing computer lab in order to showcase a new state-of-the-art computer lab with LCD ad internet facilities, new CFL lighting, false ceiling with POP work, three cassette air-conditioners, two separate glass partitions, one for Server and the other for UPS, 40 new PCs and furniture were purchased.
