Mr. President, Revered Chief Guest, Hon'y General Secretary Sahib, Distinguished Secretary & Correspondent Sahib, Distinguished Members of the Executive Committee, Professor Incharges of Shift I and II, Learned Vice-Presidents of the College Union and its Affiliated Associations, Dear Students Office - bearers, Dignitaries on and off the dais, Respected Heads of the various Departments, Faculty Members and my Dear Students, Assalamu Alaikum.

I am pleased to present before you a brief report on the functioning of Mazharul Uloom College for the odd and even semester of the Academic Year 2018-19.

After the summer vacation the college reopened on Monday, 18 June 2018 for the II, III year UG and II year PG students. Inauguration of I year UG classes for the academic year 2018-19 was held on 22 June 2018. During the occasion two videos were shown, one about the events conducted in our college during the academic year 2017-18 and the other one about the features of our college which the Pothigai channel telecasted. I year PG classes M.Com and M.Sc. IT were inaugurated on 17 August 2018.

At present the total strength of the College is 932, Shift I (572) and Shift II (360).

1. Courses Offered

We all know that the college offers 5 UG courses in Shift I and 7 UG, 4 PG and 4 Research Program in M. Phil. (English, Commerce, Computer Science and Mathematics) Full-time/ Part-time in Shift II. We also have four Ph.D. programs in Urdu, English and Commerce (Part-time).

Highlights:

- The overall admission in both Shift I and Shift II continues to be disappointing as the 65.75% in Shift I and 72.35% in Shift II seats are filled for UG the courses.
- In Shift I, the admissions in B.Com and B.Com (CS) maintained its good number, the first due to its usual demand all the time all the years and the second due to its natural next choice after B.Com.
- The admissions in the remaining 3 aided courses are not good with B.A. Corporate Economics with 33 seats, B.Sc. Mathematics with 42, and even the most-sought-after course B.Sc. Computer Science with 11 seats remaining vacant, bringing the admission percentage down (65.75% - out of 330 seats only 217 seats are filled).
- In Shift II, this academic year we had surprisingly a great demand for BCA and able to almost fill 48 of the 50 seats. BBA too had a good number of takers (52 of 70 seats). Though we got a slight raise in the number of admissions in B.Sc. (Micro Biology) comparatively to the previous academic year, but still more than 50% seats are vacant.
- **The admission in four UG courses B.A. (English), B.Sc. (ISM), B.Sc. (CS) and B.Com. (CA) was not given for not receiving considerable number of applications and these courses are continued to be suspended in this academic year (2018-19) also.** So minus these four UG courses the admissions in three UG courses (BCA, BBA and B.Sc. Microbiology) out of 170 seats, 123 are filled bringing the admission percentage a little up to 72.35%.
- The admission in the PG courses continues to be disappointing and unsatisfactory as only 8 students (12.12%) were admitted in M.Com and M.Sc. IT courses. Out of 66 seats, 58 seats are vacant in the PG courses. **Applications were not received for M.A. (English) and M.Sc. (Mathematics) and thus these courses too are continued to be suspended in this academic year (2018-19) also.**
- 21 candidates are joined in our college in the research programs M.Phil. (Commerce, Computer Science, English and Mathematics) (PT/FT).
