PRINCIPAL'S ANNUAL REPORT - 2020-2021

Mr. President, Revered Chief Guest, Hon'y General Secretary Sahib, Distinguished Secretary & Correspondent Sahib, Distinguished Members of the Executive Committee and College Committee, Learned Professor Incharges of Shift I and Shift II, Learned Vice-Presidents of the College Union and its Affiliated Associations, Dear Students Office – bearers, Dignitaries on and off the dias, Respected Heads of the various Departments, Faculty Members, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff and my dear Students. Assalamu-alaikum.

I am pleased to present before you a brief report of Mazharul Uloom College for the odd and even semester of the Academic Year 2020-21.

The regular classes in the college as usual were not started in June 2020 due to the pandemic, COVID-19 in this academic year but classes commenced through virtual meeting using Zoom and Google Meet from 04 August 2020 for II, III year UG and II year PG students. In the month of June Remedial Coaching Classes were conducted to Students who have arrears in English papers. In the month of July revision classes for all UG and PG students were conducted virtually. Inauguration of I year UG virtual classes for the academic year 2020-21 was held on 01 September 2020. All five hours classes were conducted through online.

A new subject Professional English was introduced by the University on the guidance of Government of Tamil Nadu from this academic year and thus all First year students have six hours. All these classes were conducted regularly through online. E Learning Committee was constituted to monitor all these online classes.

III year regular classes in the campus were started from 7 December 2020 for the 5th Semester. Due to Thiruvalluvar University Examinations, as per the communication from the University, I year virtual classes were cancelled from 21 December 2020 to 2 January 2021. I Year Virtual Classes for the odd semester were continued from 04 January 2021 and II year Virtual Classes for even semester from 06 January 2021. III year regular classes in the campus were started from 4 January 2021 for the 6th Semester. I Year (Odd / I Semester) and II year (IV Semester) regular classes in the campus were started from 8 February 2021.

As per the direction from the Government of Tamil Nadu G. O. No. 327, dated 22.03.2021, all students were informed that the classes would be held virtually through online mode for 6 days in a week from 23 March 2021. Study holidays were declared from 4 April 2021 to 7 April 2021 to II and III year students and their University Examinations were conducted from 08 April 2021 to 29 April 2021. Virtual classes for I year students were conducted virtually through online mode for 6 days a week till 31 May 2021.

At present the total strength of the College is 903, Shift I (625) and Shift II (278).

1. Courses Offered

The college offers 5 UG courses in Shift I and 7 UG, 4 PG and 4 Research Programmes, M.Phil. (English, Commerce, Computer Science, Mathematics) - Full-time & Part-time in Shift II. We also have 5 Ph.D. Programmes (Part-time) in Commerce, Urdu, English, Mathematics and Economics.

1. Highlights – Admissions (2020-21)

- The overall admission of this academic year is 63.94% in Shift I and 36.47% in Shift II for UG courses.

SHIFT I

- As usual there was a great demand for B.Com and the maximum applications were received only for that course. There were no significant number of applications separately for B. Com CS, B.A CE and BBA, and only with the counseling the students opted for B.Com were admitted to these courses.
- Surprisingly there was no significant number of applications received for B.Sc. CS and till date we could fill steadily 40 seats with 10 seats vacant.

- The students admitted were with average marks between 300 to 400 out of 600 marks in B.Com and B.Com CS and even less than 300 out of 600 in B.A CE and BBA.
- The admissions in B.Sc.,(Mathematics) is alarmingly not good as only 7 seats were filled so far out of 70 seats and thus 63 seats are vacant.
- In Shift I out of 330 seats 275 seats (63.94%) are filled so far in this year, 2020-21.

SHIFT II

- In Shift II, this academic year we see surprisingly a demand for BCA and almost 39 were filled out of 50 seats.
- In BBA, this year we have poor admission as only 10 seats were filled out of 70 seats and thus 60 seats are vacant.
- In B.Sc. (Micro Biology) compared to the previous academic year, we had little low admission as only 13 seats were filled so far out of 50 seats and thus 37 seats are vacant.
- **The admission in four UG courses B.A. (English), B.Sc. (ISM), B.Sc. (CS) and B.Com. (CA) was not given for not receiving considerable number of applications and thus these courses are continued to be suspended in this academic year (2020-21) also.**
- So apart from these four UG courses, the admissions in three UG courses (BCA, BBA and B.Sc. Microbiology), out of 170 seats, 62 seats are filled, bringing the admission percentage to 36.57% in this year, 2020-21.

PG COURSES & RESEARCH PROGRAMME

- The admission in the PG courses continues to be disappointing and unsatisfactory as only 2 students (3%) are admitted in M.Com course so far.
- Out of 66 seats in two PG courses M.Com and M.Sc. (IT), 64 seats are vacant.
- **Applications were not received for M.A. (English) and M.Sc. (Mathematics) and thus these courses too are continued to be suspended in this academic year (2020-21) also.**

4. Special Functions

➤ Inauguration of College Union and its Affiliated Associations

A special function through virtual meeting using zoom to inaugurate the college union and its affiliated associations was conducted today at 3.30 pm on 30 November 2020. 5. Online Classes for Students

- The Teaching and Learning process of our college continued during the lockdown periods as faculties engaged students through online. All regular classes were conducted virtually.
- ✓ **Online Remedial Classes – Dept of English**
 - Remedial classes for III year students who have arrears in English I, II, III and IV papers were held from 01 June 2020 to 30 June 2020. All staff of the English department engaged these classes through Zoom, Google meet and Google classrooms.
- ✓ **E-Learning Committee Report**
 - On 15th July E-Learning Committee was constituted by our Secretary & Correspondent under the chairmanship of Prof. A. Zakiudeen Ahmed to conduct and monitor online Revision classes for the academic year 2019-20 from 20 July to 31 July 2020 and Online Regular classes for the academic year 2020-21 from 1 August 2020 onwards.
 - Preliminary arrangements were started by creating a whatsapp group with the name “E-Learning Committee - MUC”. Each EL committee member was assigned a department with the purpose of making arrangements for the smooth conduct of online revision classes and also to make them prepare to monitor the conduct of classes and students’ attendance.
 - On 17 July HoD’s virtual meeting was held at 3 pm. Our Executive Secretary welcomed all the participants of the virtual meeting. Our Secretary & Correspondent presided over the meeting and also inaugurated the online classes.
 - On 19th July all staff and EL committee virtual meeting was held to discuss the conduct of online classes.

- EL-Committee members were communicated the mentors and asked them to create class-wise students whatsapp groups and asked them to add all the teachers in that, those who are handling classes for that particular class, so that the teachers can send the link to students to join the online classes on scheduled time.
- EL Committee members gave training to the staff members personally those who were not adapted to digital platform earlier on how to use the Zoom and Google meet Apps for teaching purpose.
- With the blessings of Almighty Allah, online Revision classes started on 20 July 2020 and smoothly completed without any disruption. All EL committee members monitored the classes and posted the attendance in the E-Learning Committee Whatsapp Group.
- A virtual Meeting of the E-Learning Committee through Zoom was held at 11:30 am on Saturday, 25 July 2020 to review the conduct of online classes. Our Secretary & Correspondent presided over the meeting.
- Regular online classes for the academic 2020-21 for II and III year UG and II year PG classes started from 4 August 2020.
- Staff members are asked to enter the students' attendance using Google sheet created by our EL committee member Mr. A. Aqueel Ahmed.
- Daily report on online class was also sent to the Joint Director of Collegiate Education by our Principal.
- Online classes were started from 4 August 2020 for II and III Year classes for III and V Semester respectively. As per norms, we have to conduct classes for 90 days per semester. We completed 91 working days on 30 November 2020. Study holidays were declared for II and III year UG classes and II year PG Classes from 1 December 2020 and students were asked to prepare for the forthcoming Odd Semester University Examinations - December 2020, **however the online classes for I year students continued upto 19 December 2020.**
- III year regular classes in the campus were started from 7 December 2020 for the 5th Semester. Due to Thiruvalluvar University Examinations, as per the communication from the University, I year virtual classes were suspended from 21 December 2020 to 2 January 2021.
- CIA Tests I, II and III were conducted by the respective subject teachers based on the communication received from the Thiruvalluvar University and marks were entered online in the Thiruvalluvar University portal after getting approval from the respective department HODs under the supervision of Examination Section.
