Mr. President, Revered Chief Guests, Hon'y General Secretary Sahib, Distinguished Secretary & Correspondent Sahib, Distinguished Members of the Executive Committee and College Committee, Learned Vice-Principals (Admin & Academic), Learned Vice-Presidents of the College Union and its Affiliated Associations, Dear Students Office – bearers, Dignitaries on and off the Dais, Respected Heads of the various Departments, Faculty Members, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff and my dear Students.

Assalamu-alaikum.

I am pleased to present before you a Annual report of our Mazharul Uloom College for the odd and even semester of the Academic Year 2021-22.

The regular classes in the college in this academic year commenced through virtual Platform using Google Meet from 21 June 2021. Regular classes for III year UG and II year PG, Revision classes for I year UG and I year PG students were started from 21 June 2021 virtually. All staff members were instructed to use Google Meet Application only for the online classes. From 9 August 2021 classes for II year UG were started virtually as per the Government Guidelines. All the faculties were attending college from 9 August 2021 and SOP were followed strictly in the college campus. All six hours classes were conducted regularly through online as per the direction from the University. E Learning Committee monitored all these online classes.

Admission of I year UG and I year PG for the academic year 2021-22 was started on 02 August 2021.

As per the direction from the Tamil Nādu government the classes in the campus were resumed to II Year (UG & PG) and III Year UG students from 1 September 2021. All the classes were conducted with 100% strength and 6 days per week except for II and III year B. Com (Corporate Secrearyship) and B.Com (General) which were held on blended mode with students divided into two

batches - with odd roll no students batch attending three days in physical mode and even roll no students attending three days online mode and vice versa.

Admission of I year UG and I year PG for the academic year 2021-22 was closed on 11 November 2021.

Dr. K.H. Kaleemullah, Principal i/c inaugurated I Year classes for the Academic year 2021-22 on 27 September 2021. Students Induction Programme (SIP) was conducted from 27 September 2021 to 01 October 2021. A One week Bridge course was also conducted for I year students from 4 October 2021 to 16 October 2021. Regular classes for I years students commenced from 11 October 2021.

Model Examinations for II and III year classes were held from 16 December 2021 to 07 January 2022.

As per the Government of Tamil Nadu direction college remained closed between 3 January 2022 and 20 January 2022, in order to prevent spread of 3rd Wave Omicron variant virus. The online classes were conducted to I year students from 10 January 2022. Mid Vacation holidays for Students of II & III year were declared up to 31 January 2022.

Thiruvalluvar University Examinations for the Odd Semester were conducted online mode from 3 February 2022 to 24 February 2022. Central valuations were also conducted in the college from 8 February.

The College for Even semester of the academic year was started for all classes from 2 March 2022. All the 3 CIA Tests were conducted properly and marks were submitted to the Examinations Centre. Model Examinations for all classes were started on 11 June 2022.

At present the total strength of the College is 928, Shift I (645) and Shift II (283).

1. Courses Offered:

The college offers 5 UG courses in Shift I and 7 UG, 4 PG and 4 Research Programmes, M.Phil. (English, Commerce, Computer Science, Mathematics) (Full-time and Part-time) in Shift II. We also have 5 Ph.D. Programmes (Part- time) in Commerce, Urdu, English, Mathematics and Economics.

Highlights – Admissions (2021-22)

Shift I

- As usual there was a great demand for B. Com (G) and the maximum applications were received only for this course.
- The students admitted were with average marks between 300 to 400 out of 600 marks in B.Com and B.Com CS and even less than 300 out of 600 in B.A CE and BBA.

- This year there was a significant number of applications received for B.Sc. Computer Science
- The admissions in B.Sc. (Mathematics) is alarmingly not good as only 19 seats were filled out of 70 seats and thus 51 seats are vacant.
- In Shift I out of 330 seats, 212 seats (64.24%) are filled in this year, 2021-22.

Shift II

- In Shift II, this academic year we can see a great demand for BCA course and all the 50 were filled.
- In BBA, this year we have poor admission as only 31 seats were filled out of 70 seats and thus 39 seats are vacant.
- In B.Sc. (Micro Biology), compare to the previous academic year, we had little low admission as only 26 seats were filled out of 50 seats and thus 24 seats are vacant.
- The admission in four UG courses B.A. (English), B.Sc. (ISM), B.Sc. (CS) and B.Com. (CA) was not given for not receiving considerable number of applications and thus these courses are continued to be suspended in this academic year (2021-22) also.

PG Courses & Research Programme

- The admission in the PG courses continues to be disappointing and unsatisfactory as only 10 students (30%) were admitted in M.Com course. Out of 40 seats in M.Com, 30 seats are vacant in this academic year.
- M.A. (English), M.Sc. (IT) and M.Sc. (Mathematics) and these courses remain suspended in this academic year (2021-22) also.
- As per the NEP the admission in M.Phil. Courses were not given.
- 10 Students joined in M.Com

Ph.D. Commerce (Full Time) Affiliation

Department of Commerce of our College offers Part Time Ph.D. program in Commerce and so far has produced 7 Ph.Ds. We have now applied for Affiliation for fulltime Ph.D. Two members Affiliation Commission visited the college on February 4, 2022 for inspection and have submitted the report to the University. Affiliation Order from the University is awaited.

- On 10 June 2021 virtual meeting was conducted by our Secretary & Correspondent to discuss the conduct of online classes for the AY 21-22 from 17th June 2021 for II UG & PG and III Year UG classes. Members present in this meeting: Principal, Vice Principals (Administration & Academic), EL Committee chairman and Dr. Asadullah.
- On 12 June 2021 virtual meeting was held at 12:30 pm by our Principal to discuss the conduct of online classes for the AY 2021-22 with the E-Learning Committee. Discussed about the common platform to be used for taking online classes.
- On 14 June 2021 at 10:00 am Secretary sahib held a virtual meeting with Principal, Vice Principal, EL Chairman and Technical Team Leader (Dr.BA). Decided to use “Google Meet” as common platform. Secretary sahib asked us to have a virtual meeting with the Trainer to know about “Google Meet” app at 12:00 Noon same day itself. He also informed us that the online classes would commence from 21st June 2021 instead of 17th June 2021.
- On 14 June 2021 at 12:00 Noon, Mr. Vijay (Trainer) has given demo on “Use of Google workspace for teaching & Learning upgrade” to Vice Principals (Dr. ASAK and Dr.PRA), EL-Chairman (Prof.AZ), Technical Team Leader (Dr.BA) and Dr. N. Fathima Thabasum. Trainer explained us about the features of Google Workspace for teaching & Learning (i.e, paid version Google Meet). He said that 100 TB storage space would be provided to each individual subscriber by the Google.

- On 15 June 2021 at 12:00 Noon on virtual demo session on paid version of “ Google Meet “was conducted by Dr. N. Fathima Thabasum to EL-Committee members along with Principal and Vice Principals.
- Training Programme on “Google Meet” was organized by IQAC on 10 June 2021 at 11:00 am to impart training to all the staff members. Dr. N. Fathima Thabasum was the resource person. She explained all features available in paid version of Google Meet.
- With the blessings of Almighty Allah, online classes started on 21st June 2021 to the final year classes smoothly conducted without any disruption. All the EL committee members monitored the classes and posted the attendance in the E-Learning Committee WhatsApp Group. Staff members are asked to enter the students’ attendance of respective classes using Google sheet created & maintained by our EL committee member Hafiz A. Aqueel Ahmed.
- Daily report on online class is also sent to the JD office by our Principal and its prepared by EL committee member Mr. Mohamed Aalam.
- Online classes for II Year UG classes began from 9 August 2021 (Monday) with 6 hours per day.
- On 24 August 2021 at 3:00 pm Secretary sahib convened a virtual meeting with Principal, Vice Principals, EL-Chairman (Prof.AZ) and Technical Team Leader (Dr. BA) to discuss the commencement of physical classes to the II UG & PG and III UG classes from 1 September 2021. Decided to have blended learning to the II and III Year Students of Corporate Secretaryship and Commerce departments.
- I Year classes for the Academic year 2021-22 were inaugurated by Principal i/c on 27 September 2021. Students Induction Programme (SIP) was conducted from 27 September 2021 to 01 October 2021. Mr. A. Nayeemullah Khan, Assistant Professor of Commerce conducted SIP very excellently in this academic year.
- As per the direction from the secretary sahib to streamline the students who come from schools to know and cope up the college studies, One week Bridge course was conducted for I year students from 4 October 2021 to 16 October 2021. Actual classes for I years as per the university curriculum started from 11 October 2021 onwards.

- Model Examinations for II and III year classes were conducted from 16 December 2021 to 07 January 2022 and during this period regular offline classes were conducted for I year classes. Students prepared themselves well to face the examinations by writing the model examinations.
