Principal's Report

Presented at the 48th College Day Celebrations on Monday, 26.09.2016

Mr. President, Revered Chief Guest, Hon'y General Secretary Sahib, Distinguished Secretary & Correspondent Sahib, Distinguished Members of the Executive Committee, Learned Vice-Presidents of the Various Associations of the College Union, Dear Students Office-bearers, the Dignitaries on and off the dais, Respected Heads of the Departments, Members of Various Faculty, and my Dear Students, Assalam - ualaikum.

I am pleased to present before you a brief report on the functioning of Mazharul Uloom College for the odd and even semester of the Academic Year 2016-17.

After the summer vacation the college reopened on Thursday, 16 June 2016 for the II, III year UG and II year PG students. Inauguration of I year UG classes for the academic year 2016-17 was held on 24 June 2016. During the occasion two videos were shown, one about the events of our college held during the academic year 2015-16 and the other one about the features of our college which the Pothigai channel telecasted. I year PG classes were inaugurated on 01 August 2016.

At present the total strength of the College is 937, Shift I (575) and Shift II (362) respectively.

- The department of Corporate Secretaryship has produced 100% results in 4 subjects in III year & 2 subjects in II year. Out of 44 students, 33 students have passed and got their degree, the percentage of pass is 75%.
- The department of Commerce has produced 53% of results as 25 students have qualified themselves to get degree.

In Shift I 61% students have passed and got their degrees.

- The department of Business Administration has produced 74 % results. 34 students have passed out of 46.
- The department of Computer Application has produced 100% results in two subjects.
- The department of Information System Management has produced 100% results in four subjects.
- The department of Micro Biology has produced 100% results.
- The Post graduate department of English has produced 100 % results.
- The Post graduate department of Computer Science has produced 100% results.
- In Shift II 45% students have passed and got their degrees.
- In the academic year 2015-16, in Shift I 109 students and in Shift II 86 students have got their degrees.

Highlights:

- The overall admission in both Shift I and Shift II continues to be disappointing with 59.70% (197/330) in Shift I and 26.59% (109/410) in Shift II for UG courses.
- In Shift I 47% seats are vacant in Economics and 67% seats are vacant in Mathematics Department. Even the most-sought-after courses B.Com and B. Com (CS) also have considerable number of seats vacant. The B.Sc Computer Science has not reached its maximum.
- In Shift II the situation continues to be pathetic as all most all the department have more than 40% seats vacant. 94% in English, 92% in ISM and 87% in B.Com (CA) making the situation very alarming. With regard to the PG the admission are only in single digit number with just 13.01% (19/146).

4. Special Functions.

Environment Awareness Program

The commencement of the spoken English classes took place with a launching programme on 2 January 2017, at the N. M. Zackariah Auditorium by our Secretary & Correspondent Alijanab Alhaj M. Nazar Mohamed Sahib. In his address he insisted to learn good English for better future. Dr. P. M. Aadil Ahmed, Principal spoke on the occasion and said that good English is required for getting good studies and jobs. The centre assures the students to learn English with innovative language teaching methods with the aid of the language lab. It provides an opportunity to the students to learn and speak English while still pursuing their degree, as most of the students are from schools with vernacular medium of instruction and from the rural background. The language is taught through programmed lessons bought at a cost of Rs 1.25 lakhs (Courtesy – UGC). Every learner is provided with a system. There are 25 systems (Thin – Client). A coordinator along with the two instructors is exclusively appointed for this Centre. A 50 hour programme, one hour per day in five batches

scheduled for three months (January to March) has commenced with the enrollment of 125 students, 25 in each batch. Of the five batches three are for the Shift II students (one batch exclusively for girl students) and two are for the Shift I students. The timing is one hour per day for each batch, forenoon for Shift II and afternoon for Shift I.

Republic Day Celebrations

Republic Day was celebrated at our College on Tuesday, 26 January 2017 at 09.00 a.m. Principal hoisted the National Flag and addressed the gathering.
