- The parties to this memorandum may, by mutual consent, add, modify, amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition(s) of the agreement.
- The MOU shall remain in force for a period of **5 five years** from the date of its signature and seal and may be terminated by either side by giving a six-month notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.
