NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC) POLICY DOCUMENT

National Cadet Corps was established under NCC act 1948. The NCC offers opportunities for military training to College students, without imposing on them any obligation for active Military Service.

Objectives of NCC

1. To develop qualities, character, courage comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, sportsmanship and the ideal of selfless service among the youth to make them useful citizens.
2. To create, a human resource organized, trained and motivated youths, to provide leadership in all walks of his life, including in armed forces and always to be available to serve the Nation. Members of the Corps have no liability for military service but have definite obligation for regular training.
3. To make NCC Cadets to be punctual and workhard and without fuss to do selfless service to the nation by joining the defense services.

Functions of NCC


1. Cadets will have two Parades a week, each of two hours duration. Parades will not interfere with the academic work and come to a close in about three weeks before the Examinations.
2. Government Uniform is issued free of cost to all Cadets which should be worn in all parades on the campus.
3. Our cadets attend National Integration Camp (NIC) conducted at all India level at different places which develop the habit of integration of the students irrespective of caste, creed, color, religion, etc. where everyone comes to know the cultural tradition of other states.
4. All the Cadet undertakes to continue in the Corps until discharged, or on leaving the college or on approved medical grounds.
5. Discharge Certificate will be issued to all Cadets which will carry weightage in the recruitment of uniformed service.
6. All the Cadet participate in the social service activities like college campus cleaning.

The uniform and other stores issued to the Cadets shall be returned to the N.C.C. Officer, in a clean, washed and pressed condition, on the last Parade day of the year or when the Cadet discontinues from N.C.C/College or when the Officer demands.
