The **NSS policy** of our college is not different from that set by the NSS of Government of India guidelines mentioned in the NSS manual available in the NSS Portal. The **National Service Scheme (NSS)** is an Indian government sector public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year in 1969. Aimed at developing student's personality through community service, NSS is a voluntary association of young people in Colleges, Universities and at +2 level working for a campus-community (esp. Villages) linkage. Our College abides by all the rules and guidelines set by the Government. Every Year a 100 students are enrolled in the NSS.

Objectives:

The broad objectives of NSS for the volunteers are to:

- (i) To understand the community in which they work
- (ii) To understand themselves in relation to their community;
- (iii) To identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process;
- (iv) To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility;
